We are holding drop in sessions for people with a learning disability and carers that live in the Ryhope area



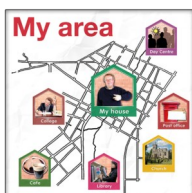

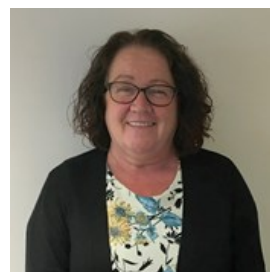
Who will be at the September Drop-in?
